- 2020 BGMC Christmas Gift campaign. These projects are open through the first 6 months of 2020. You can view that catalog and download media for those projects <u>HERE</u>.
- 2. Asia Pacific is a whole region of opportunities for BGMC help.
- 3. CompACT Family Services has a need for supplies that help them care for kids, mothers, and families. These projects ensure that children will have their spiritual, physical and emotional needs met by loving, caring, and committed individuals. Their commitment is to Redeeming vulnerable children and families through COMPASSIONATE ACTION to the glory of God..
- 4. Uttam's Place is an outreach to young girls in Bangladesh. They give girls a place to be restored and encourage in the mist of poverty, hardships, and danger. Girls come to Uttam's Place because they are loved, encouraged, and have a chance to feel safe.
- 5. Backyard Orphans trains churches to care for orphans. Their track record is amazing and they are continuing to do amazing things through the foster care and adoption services across many states. You can help them expand and keep kids out of unsafe environments right here in the USA.
- 6. One Hope feels called to devote all of their resources to providing children and youth with relevant Gospel messages. They have two BGMC projects. One: World Without Sickness This program provides many open doors that would otherwise be nonexistent due to evangelism restrictions in many countries in Asia Pacific. Ministry partners are given access to share the Gospel in schools when they are also providing much needed hygiene education. Two: Hosanna Plan An estimated 100,000 communities in Russia lack a Christian church, but the Hosanna Plan brings God's Word to remote regions. Young adults dedicate one year of their lives to travel across Russia, sharing the Gospel and planting churches.
- 8. Network211 uses 21st Century technology to communicate the 1st Century Gospel by helping people discover and grow in their journey with God. They are currently raising funds for an initiative to expand their efforts to every top ten language on the internet. Here is a statement from the Network211 director... "The church could give towards global evangelism in nations that persecute Christians. Recently, I was asked to create a report to show what the Lord is doing with Network211 in a restricted nation. So, I found Open Door's Watch List of Nations with Extreme Persecution and compared it to Network211 all-time statistics. I discovered that we have presented the Gospel to over 7.2 million people in these nations! In many of these countries, missionaries are not allowed and believers are persecuted openly. Yet, we can respond to them as we use the Internet as a tool of the Gospel. God is not limited by politics, borders, or the desires of humanity."

9. Critical Needs Fund (CNF) - Offerings sent to BGMC that are not designated to a project go into the CNF. This helps missionaries who are faced with urgent needs that require immediate help. These funds go to the Assemblies of God world missions senior leadership to meet critical needs across the world, often <u>assisting missionaries risking their lives to serve in sensitive countries.</u> BGMC always encourages churches to raise money for both projects and this fund throughout the year.
